Description of Activity	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Show the students the poster and explain to them that 480 BC is a milestone for the Acropolis, the end of the archaic age, and the beginning of the glorious classical period we all know. 2. Discuss the important events of this era that define its historical context. 3. Give instruction to the students to look for specific exhibits from this period. 4. Point out that the exhibits you will see during your tour of the archaic collection room are divided into three main categories and describe them. 5. Students play the game "A Greek temple".
